<b>Bodega Lurton Reserva Pinot Gris, Valle d'Uco, Argentina 2009</b> This extremely fresh wine exhibits peach and melon flavours, backed by a hint of butter on the finish. Light and refreshing.	£8.00
<b>Mission Estate Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand 2009</b> A ripe bouquet of citrus, passion fruit and gooseberry. The palate is crisp, fruity and dry with a clean finish.	£9.50

**Muskat Trollinger, Germany 2008** £9.00  
Salmon color. Red and white currant, gooseberry and orange on the nose. Fresh acidity, spice and floral fruit flavours on the palate.

**St Clair Pinot Noir Rose, New Zealand 2008** £10.00  
Floral notes with black cherry, plum and currant aromas. Fresh, and well balanced.

## Red wines

**St Amour, le Cru des Amoureux, Domaine Paradis, Beaujolais, France 2008** £7.00  
A beautiful, deep purple hue with a berrylike taste.

**Dolcetto d'Alba "le Coste", Italy 2009** £8.50  
Sage and red cherry fruit aromas pepper this fine nose, whilst the palate remains refined.

**Hacienda Araucano, Central Valley Pinot Noir, Chile 2009** £10.00  
This elegant wine possesses a beautiful ruby colour robe and a long finish. It exhibits notes of red fruits and vanilla aromas.

**Givry 1er Cru "Clos de Bois Chevaux" Domaine Joblot, France 2006** £15.00  
A powerful yet elegant Pinot Noir, matured in new oak.

**Haan Shiraz Barossa Prestige, Australia 2006** £17.00  
Intense, with spice, blackberry and earth aromas and subtle hints of vanilla.

**Château Cantemerle 5ème Cru Classé Haut Médoc, France 2000** £23.00  
Charming and elegant with delicate aromas of spice and ripe fruit.

**"1753" de Château de Campuget, Costières de Nimes, France 2007** £8.00  
An intense wine with black cherry aromas combined (*Served from Magnum 80<sup>th</sup> Anniversary*) with a smoke liquorice character and a hint of chocolate.

**Piedra Negra Malbec, Lurton Mendoza, Argentina 2006** £15.00  
This superb Malbec has a beautiful and intense purple colour. Its fruity nose of ripe black fruits is subtly combined to spiced notes of cinnamon and nutmeg with a hint of dried tobacco.

**Moscatel Oro, Miguel Torres, Catalonia, Spain** £9.00  
An unmistakable aroma, characteristic of the variety, with seductive floral scents. The palate is voluptuous and delicately sensual.

**Elysium, Black Muscat Quady, California, USA 2008** £9.00  
Rich and full-flavoured with a bouquet of roses and ripe berries. Excellent with puddings.

**Baron Philippe de Rothschild, Sauternes Mouton Cadet Réserve 2006** £12.50  
A rich and elegant blend of Sémillon, Sauvignon Blanc and Muscadelle producing a highly concentrated nose of honey with fresh notes of acacia and lime blossom.

**Muscadel 1908 Reserve Old Vines, Rietvallei estate, Robertson, South Africa 2008** £13.50  
Red Muscadel vines. Reddish in colour, with the tantalising Muscat aroma of flowers, orange peel, raisins and spices. These continue on the palate to a sublimely delicate lingering finish.

Beautiful white gold with delicate and elegant bubbles. Well balanced with a beautiful finish.

A subtle blend of spice, with hints of citrus and warm toasted notes, balance the freshness of the fruit.	
<b>Champagne Paul Berthelot Cuvée de Réserve Brut NV</b>	£70.00
Ripe fruit and honey slightly mentholated. The palate is well structured with notes of apple, pear and currant with a slight mint and anise, which gives a good length.	
<b>Louis Roederer Brut Premier NV</b>	£98.00
A structured and elegantly mature wine with fresh fruit overtones.	
<b>Bollinger Spécial Cuvée Brut NV</b>	£118.00
60% Pinot Noir, 25% Chardonnay and 15% Pinot Meunier, harvested from 30 different crus in Champagne.	
<b>Krug Grande Cuvée Brut NV</b>	£340.00
Classically rich and opulent in style yet with a sublime balance and elegance. Aromas of baked brioche.

Golden yellow colour with green highlights and a steady stream of fine and persistent bubbles. The nose is marked by ripe fruits and honey while on the palate there is a sense of complexity depth of flavour and a youthful freshness with a long finish of yellow stone fruits.	
<b>Bernard Bremont Grand Cru Vintage 2002</b>	£110.00
In special bottle, always the product of an exceptional year, selected from the grapes from our best exposed plots. It consists of 55% Pinot Noir and 45% Chardonnay.	
<b>Billecart Salmon Cuvée Nicolas Francois Billecart 1998</b>	£182.00
Pale gold with aromas of white flowers, mixed with subtle notes of brioche. The balance between richness and persistence is the hallmark of this accomplished wine.	
<b>Bollinger Grande Année 2000</b>	£205.00
Intensely rich and powerful flavours of toasted nuts, wild fruits and crème brûlée abound.	
<b>Cristal Brut 2002</b>	£420.00
An intense bouquet with scents of white flowers borne by hawthorn and vine and the aroma of fresh almonds.	
<b>Krug Clos d'Ambonnay 1995</b>	£4500.00
Ample and mature. A harmony of brioche, grilled almonds, candied spices and lush red berries with an elegant finish

Light and a delicate yellow in colour, with delicious aromas of melon, apple and grapefruit. Perfectly fresh and fruity.	
<b>L'Herre, Gros Manseng Sauvignon, Côtes de Gascogne 2010</b>	£35.00
The Gros Manseng gives an exotic expression of ripe apricot and a touch of spice to the crisp, more citrus, fruit notes of the Sauvignon.	
<b>Côtes du Rhône Blanc Domaine de la Solitude 2008</b>	£39.00
Peach, citrus, date, fig and a hint of banana with a touch of spice are all characteristic aromas of white Rhône wines.	
<b>Baron Philippe de Rothschild Pays d'Oc Sauvignon Blanc 2009</b>	£39.00
Attractive Sauvignon notes, lemon zest and a floral touch reminiscent of jasmine and white lilac. Displaying plenty of body and crisp, fresh flavours.

This Sauvignon Blanc is reminiscent of fresh green grass and grapefruit with whispers of passion fruit and honey.

A fresh and crisp bouquet with the characteristic liveliness of Riesling. Discreetly fruity with a mineral touch.

An elegant and dry wine with subtle citrus and white flower aromas leading to a classically dry mineral taste, characteristic of Sauvignon Blanc.

Notes of apricot, vanilla, acacia and white pepper. A beautiful structure, balance and finish.	
<b>Pouilly Fumé de Ladoucette 2008</b>	£89.00
At Château du Nozet, Baron Ladoucette follows a family tradition producing some of the best Loire wines available. Superb Pouilly-Fumé with pungent elder-tinged fruit and a smoky, steely finish.	
<b>Highland Estates Camelot Chardonnay 2007</b>	£98.00
Tropical flavours of pineapple, mango and papaya with a rich and velvet textured finish. Notes of cinnamon, candied lime and crème brûlée	
<b>Chablis Grand Cru, Vaudesir, G. Tremblay 2008</b>	£162.00
This magnificent elegant Chardonnay of golden colour has a powerful mineral and fruity nose with delicate scents of white apple blossom.

Black cherry and plum flavours from this juicy, mouthfilling Merlot wine which finishes soft and supple on the palate with velvety tannins.

Juicy black fruits and black pepper spice combine with vanilla notes.	
<b>Baron Philippe de Rothschild Pays d'Oc Merlot 2008</b>	£41.00
Red fruit, cherry and raspberry aromas enhanced by touches of spice, reflect its Mediterranean origins.	
<b>Côtes du Rhône, Domaine de la Solitude Pierre Lancon 2007</b>	£43.00
A dense, ruby red wine with aromas of cherry, plum, vanilla, pepper and hints of spice.

An abundance of rich, red fruit flavours and molten tannins.	
<b>Château Fleur de Lisse, St Emilion 2006</b>	£57.00
A well structured St Emilion with a pleasant fruit bouquet.

Spicy, mint, cherry, smoky, herb nose. Elegant palate. Has some concentration and length.	
<b>Nuits St Georges "les Hauts Poirets" Machard Gramont 2006</b>	£97.00
Well-balanced fruit flavours and a truly elegant palate.	
<b>Châteauneuf du Pape, Domaine de la Solitude Pierre Lancon 2007</b>	£99.00
Fine aromas of blackcurrant and blackberry dominate with spicy undertones of pepper and nutmeg.	
<b>Le Dome, St Emilion Grand Cru 2004</b>	£108.00
Superbly balanced and elegant with a typically high percentage of Cabernet Franc. (Parker 93)	
<b>La Fleur de Haut Bages Liberal Pauillac 2002</b>	£168.00
Second wine of Chateau Haut Bages. Dominated by Cabernet Sauvignon it is marked by the richness of its tannins, which give a roundness to the taste.	
<b>Hermitage 1998, Domaine Jean Louis Chave</b>	£398.00
Full-bodied and concentrated with a powerful tannic structure.	
<b>La Tâche Grand Cru, Domaine de la Romanée Conti 2001</b>	£3,500.00
Red fruits displaying a spicy overlay and hints of tar. A spicy tannic structure whilst fresh fruits dominate.	
<b>Pétrus 1988</b>	£4900.00
Concentrated, rich flavoured and unique. Incredible power, depth and richness with remarkable balance with aromas of ripe mulberry, black currant and fruit with spicy vanilla oak.	
<b>Château Mouton Rothschild 1961</b>	£9,900.00
No longer opaque, mature. Lovely, fragrant, spicy bouquet and flavour.
